Giner-Pascual et al. 2011 Spain PCT N=45	<p><b>Population:</b> SCI: all subjects with tendinopathy of the shoulder; Type of pain=musculoskeletal.</p> <p><b>Treatment:</b> Patients were divided into a treatment and placebo group. The treatment group received a quarter of a 1.25mg NT patch over the shoulder and were followed for 6-months. The placebo group received a placebo patch.</p> <p><b>Outcome Measures:</b> SCIM; WUSPI; VAS.</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Significant improvement was seen in the primary outcome measures including SCIM, WUSPI, and VAS at 6 month follow-up.</li> <li>2. Those in the treatment group reported a number of side effects including headaches, facial reddening, dizziness, and tachycardia.</li> </ol>
